In order to be covered by insurance, all clubs, coaches, and athletes must be currently registered with USA Wrestling. All tournaments must be sanctioned by USAW. Start times and Entry Fees for all AZ/USATournaments are the same.

**Entry Fee: \$15 for one style \$20 for two styles. \$5 late fee if pairing has started. Floor Pass: \$10 per tournament**  
**USAW Cards - \$35 Online \$40 at tournament Club Charters - \$100 (see David Gonzalez)**

**Kids: Registration/Weigh-ins - 8:00 to 8:30 am Cadets/Juniors/Opens: Registration/Weigh-ins - 10:30 to 11:00 am**  
**All wrestlers will weigh in wearing only a singlet. If only one wrestler in weight class, can either get refund or medal.**

Some weight classes may be combined to provide wrestling opportunities but wrestlers can only medal in original weight. Wrestlers can only wrestle up one weight class. Wrestlers can not wrestle in a different age group. Cadets can with doctor's note.

Pool bracketing will be used with a point system to separate top wrestlers into different pools. See reverse for more information. Point system: 5 points for 1st, 3 points for 2nd and 1 point for 3rd. Points accumulate throughout the season. Top wrestlers will be separated based on number of pools. 2 pools, 2 top wrestlers separated. 3 pools, 3 top wrestlers separated.

Spectator Admission Fees: \$1 for children; \$3 for adults (USAW cardholders get free entry if they show their card)

All age groups will wrestle at each tournament unless specifically noted.

**Copper Certification** is required to coach at any National or Kids Qualifier and any State or Regional Championship.  
**Bronze Certification** is required to coach at any National Tournament or to be on any National Coach Staff.

- 1 Pool Round robin wrestling - Everyone wrestles everyone.
- 2 Pools Pool winners go for 1st and 2nd. Second place pool wrestlers go for 3rd and 4th.
- 3 Pools Pool winners go for 1st and 2nd in round robin match up (top pool).  
Second place pool wrestlers go in round robin match up (bottom pool).  
Last place wrestler in top pool wrestles winner of bottom pool for 3rd and 4th.
- 4 pools Pool winners go for 1st and 2nd in round robin match up (top pool).  
Second place pool wrestlers go in round robin match up (bottom pool).  
2 last place wrestlers in top pool wrestle 2 winners of bottom pool in round robin.
- 5 Pools or more Break into 2 super pools and follow format above to determine top 2 wrestlers  
Top 2 wrestlers in super pool will then wrestle round robin to determine medals.

### **Advancement, Placement and Tie-Breaker Criteria**

1. The most victories in the round.
2. The most classification points in the round.
3. The most falls in the round
4. The most wins by technical superiority in the round
5. The most periods won by superiority in the round.
6. The most technical points scored in the round.
7. The least number of technical points given up in the round.
8. The wrestler with the lowest recorded weight (from weigh-ins)
